«*The rise of offices venality in France: 1467-1604*»

Résumé :

This session focuses on the emergence of *offices* as an exchange-value in France in the 16th Century. Before the emergence of venality *offices* are a delegation of the Royal Authority. In 1467, officials obtain from the King the end of their revocability. Then *offices* start to be valued in monetary terms through the resignation process. The *offices* primary market has moved from a decentralised to a centralised form with the creation of the Casual Parties in 1522. In 1604 a tax innovation called *la Paulette* has definitely transformed the secondary market for *offices* into an asset market.
