- 2010 - ...** The Brazilian experience on third-line antiretroviral for patients in virological treatment failure.

Abstract: Brazil, which has one of the largest patients cohort (315 000 people on TARV), and one of the oldest, is the first country in the south to confront the challenge of third-line treatments distribution. Currently, the National Program HIV/AIDS distributes six third-line ARV (Darunavir, enfuvirtide, étravirine, raltégravir, tipranavir and maraviroc) to the patients in virological treatment failure. We propose two joint objectives. 1) a better understanding of the functioning of the Brazilian public health system in the specific field of fight against AIDS and with particular attention to the establishment of third-line treatments. 2) conduct a "political economy" on third-line programs regarding particularly the evolution of the purchase price of each ARV, the impact of third-lines on the total budget devoted to acquisition of ARVs in the Brazilian national AIDS program and study the conditions under which some of these ARVs are or will be acquired and / or products at reduced costs in the form of voluntary license and / or generic.

2006 – 2008 Primary Pharmaceutical Care Programs at Rio de Janeiro

Abstract: This project studies the relationship between the pharmaceutical industry and pharmaceutical care within the Unified Health System. We evaluate how the drug purchases for primary pharmaceutical care for hypertension, diabetes, asthma and rhinitis programs are done. Data was collected in Rio de Janeiro State and Municipal Health Secretariats. According to the research, Rio de Janeiro State purchases drugs of higher unit prices than the municipality. On the other hand, Rio de Janeiro Municipal administration purchases drugs through prices competition and electronic auction, what allowed them to buy drugs of lower prices. The pharmaceutical care in primary health care can be quite costly when there is no proper schedule.
